PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on March 20, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. the Planning Commission of the Township of Algoma, Kent County, Michigan will hold a public hearing at the Algoma Township Hall, 10531 Algoma Avenue, N.E., on an ordinance to amend the zoning ordinance of the Township of Algoma. The principal provisions of the proposed amending ordinance can be summarized as follows:

Driveway Cleared Width. The ordinance would amend the standards for driveways in Section 4.27 of the Zoning Ordinance by the addition of subsection (4) which would provide that a driveway shall have a cleared width of at least 20 feet, consisting of 10 feet of width on each side of the center line of the driveway, and that such width shall be cleared of all obstructions below 14 feet above the surface of the driveway and the cleared width on either side.

A copy of the proposed amending ordinance is on file and may be examined by interested persons in the office of the Township zoning administrator, at the Algoma Township Hall, at the above-stated address, during regular Township office hours.

All interested persons may attend the public hearing and comment on the proposed special land use. Written comments concerning the special land use may be submitted to the Township, to the attention of the zoning administrator, up to the time of the public hearing.
