

**TOWNSHIP OF ALGOMA**

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that on February 19, 2019, at 7:00 p.m., the Planning Commission of the Township of Algoma, Kent County, Michigan, will hold a public hearing at the Algoma Township Hall, 10531 Algoma Avenue, N.E., on an ordinance to amend the Township of Algoma Zoning Ordinance. The principal provisions of the proposed amending ordinance can be summarized as follows:

*Fences in R3 (Lake Residential) Districts.* The ordinance would amend Section 4.29 of the Township of Algoma Zoning Ordinance to prohibit any fence in a waterfront lot from being located within a setback from the ordinary high water mark of any adjacent lake unless the fence is made of chain link or other transparent material.

*Parking lot requirements (Hard surface approvals – Administrative level).* The ordinance would amend Section 26.3 of the Township of Algoma Zoning Ordinance regarding the use of alternate surface materials for parking areas.

*Residential Use Communication Towers.* The ordinance would amend Section 4.24 and 4.25 of the Township of Algoma Zoning Ordinance to change the requirements and restrictions on non-commercial or non-public antennas and towers to permit such towers and antennas up to 80 feet and to allow such towers and antennas for heights ranging from 81-120 feet upon administrative review by the Township.

The text of the proposed amending ordinance is on file and may be examined at the offices of the Algoma Township Hall, at the address above stated, during Township office hours. All interested persons may attend the public hearing and comment on the proposed amendments. Written comments concerning the amendments may be submitted to the Township office, at the above-stated address, up to the time of the public hearing.
